

The National Academy of Sciences is seeking nominations for the John J. Carty Award for the Advancement of Science, being presented in 2007 in the area of plant science. The John J. Carty Award consists of a medal and \$25,000 prize awarded to recognize noteworthy and distinguished accomplishment in any field of science within the scope of the Academy charter. The award is open to scientists from all countries, and membership in the NAS is not required to submit a nomination or to be considered for the award.
